Position Summary

On the fourth Saturday of each July, Twin Cities Carifest holds a vibrant Caribbean festival along the banks of the Mississippi river. Waste Management Volunteers are needed to maintain the health and appearance of this outdoor site during and after the festival.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Instruction and monitoring of correct waste procedures by attendees.
- Empty waste containers and replace liners.
- Collect in-crowd litter, distribute individual waste bags and collect “outlier” trash bags.
- Clean-up & tear-down tasks at the end of the evening
- Monitor BIFF’s and report issues.
- Liaison with BIFF company during cleaning

Requirements and Commitment

- Orientation package provided ahead of the event day.
- Must be available the day of the event in Minneapolis, West River Parkway and 17th Avenue.
- A minimum of a 2 hour shift is expected.

Applications accepted on a rolling basis until July 27th.*
